Art:

1. Blue and white collage
2. Sponge painting with brown paint to create the Kotel
3. Decorate Hamsah
4. Chagall Stained Glass window-Parchment paper or sticky clear contact paper or top of a clear container. Put tissue paper on top and hang up onto window.

Fine Motor Skills:

1. Beading with blue and white beads to create a bracelet or necklace
2. Write a note for Kotel
3. Write your name in English or Hebrew
4. Writing in passports

Language:

1. .Observe Chagall's artwork-Discuss: What do you see? The colors. The patterns.
2. Observe the Kotel- Discuss: What do you see? The significance. The location.
3. Create a Shuk in dramatic play- Discuss: What is a Shuk? Look at pictures from the internet. Where is a Shuk? What are you selling? Who is the customer? Price?
4. Observe passports. - Discuss: What are passports? What are they used for?
5. Observe Israel: Discuss: What is the shape of Israel? Where is Israel on the map? Compare the size and shape of Israel with other countries.
6. Pretend to fly in an airplane. Where are you going? Have you ever been in an airplane? When? Where did you go?

Discovery/Math:

1. Count Mezuzahs in your home.
2. Shekel/coin rubbings. If you don't have shekels, please print out. Compare American money and shekels
3. Weighing materials. You can use this in your shuk. Which is heavier? Lighter? You can make a weighing tool with a hanger and two cups or buckets. Attached is a pic.
4. What is the shape of Israel? How many sides does it have?
5. Counting the Omer

6. Create Star of David with popsicle sticks. Count out sticks for 2 triangles. Put one on top of another. Now how many sticks are there?

Science:

1. Experiment- Materials- 2 cups, salt, water, food coloring
1 cup- put water, salt, food coloring 1 cup-water, food coloring. What happened to the food coloring in each cup?
2. Squeeze oranges to create orange juice.
