# <u>Art:</u>

#### <u>Language:</u>

- 1. .Observe Chagall's artwork-Discuss: What do you see? The colors. The patterns.

- 3. Create a Shuk in dramatic play- Discuss: What is a Shuk? Look at pictures from the internet. Where is a Shuk? What are you selling? Who is the customer? Price?
